Log in on a school computer and go to Clever. Scroll down to the Beanstack app icon.



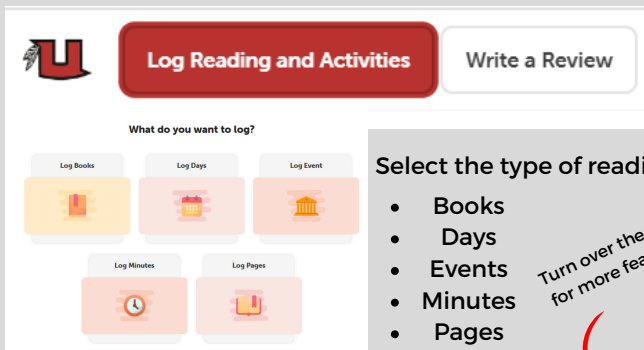
### Home Access

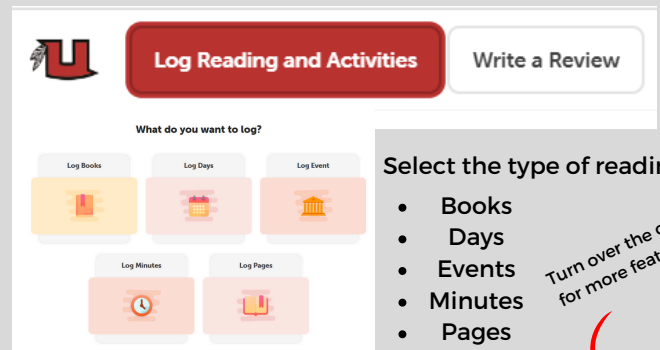
